



2. Related Degree Programs (1)





- Develop human resources who can contribute to human life and society by providing students with opportunities to study disability scientifically
- Specific forms of **support for people with disabilities**, and the foundations of such support, as well as the essential features of being human.



- Facilitate **research on various disability-related practical issues** such as researchers and educators with advanced research and education on the disability sciences
- Professionals with high-level expertise who can perform and provide research, education and instruction.
- Faculty members with a wide range of expertise in the disability sciences, from fundamental theory to practice.









2. Related Degree Programs (2)



Early Completion Doctoral Program



- Doctoral Program for **applicants with certain achievement** (checked in entrance selection procedures) in academic research
- Completion of Doctoral Degree in minimum 1 year (maximum 3 year)
- Academic courses to gain capacity in terms of **communication skill and global understanding** as postdoctoral researcher
- In the field of Pure & Applied Sci., System and Info. Eng., Life & Env. Sci., Business Sci., 21 Doctoral Programs

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

The world becomes one global campus.



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
