The title 'honorary professor' was given for his outstanding achievement in the field of mathematics education, especially, on his international contribution for establishment of the global standards on lesson study, particularly to APEC (Asian Pacific Economical Cooperation). The Peruvian government established Master Program in education for school teachers at four Universities with full salary-scholarship to realize "the global standards in the education" this September. Out of the six hundred students in all four universities, three hundred twenty students are enrolled in University of St. Ignatius of Loyola (Universidad San Ignacio de Loyola), Lima, Peru. This is the largest established program in Peru. English and Mathematical Competencies are two major competencies on the 21st century skills in the world curriculum reform issues. Peru in particular has problems on mathematics and language literacy based on International Survey.

The ceremony was conducted to inaugurate the establishment of master's program at USIL. Center for Research on International Cooperation in Educational Development (CRICED) has been hosting APEC Lesson Study Mathematics Project. This award is not only to acknowledge his personal efforts but also to recognize his outstanding achievement on the project with 21 economies' leading researchers.

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
