 Since 2016, PALS has been partnering with public and private schools to explain and promote lesson study and support teachers in their conduct of lesson study through trainings and seminars.














First National Convention on Lesson Study in April 2019











Module 1: Data Science and Data in our Everyday Lives

- An introductory module for Data Science that discusses the ubiquity of data in our daily lives and in teaching and how it relates to various fields.
- Covers skill sets that are needed for engaging in Data Science and how processing leads to useful information.













Module 2: Data Visualization

- Presents different ways that data can be visualized based on the kind and nature of data – to enable meaningful interpretations.
- Participants become familiar with tools for data visualization.











Module 3: Exploratory Data Analysis

- Provides practical discussions and hands-on activities for preparing data for exploratory data analysis.
- Covers handling different sources of data and missing data as well as common ways for evaluating whether data are useful for further analysis













Module 4: Machine Learning

- Covers some supervised and unsupervised learning techniques for classification, prediction, and clustering.
- Discusses different methods for evaluating the performance of a machine learning model.











Module 5: Natural Language Processing

 Discusses some text processing techniques and the application of machine learning algorithms to the processed data


