




#### 2. How to get to { Junior High School, University of Tsukuba (Feb.13) University of Tsukuba (Feb.14,16)

Feb. 13: Do not go to Elementary School.




## Meeting Point of the Feb 13 at 8:30am.

## Meeting Point of the Feb 14




On Feb. 14,
