#### **Background**

 To help the improvement of the less developed schools, the 32<sup>nd</sup> SEAMEO Council Conference held in Manila in February 1997, gave the agreement to the launching and implementation of the SEAMEO Community Involvement Project

 The Council recommended undertaking the development and promotion of a school adoption programme in Member Countries.

- Aim of the Community Involvement Programme
  - aim at improving the quality of life of the student through direct or indirect assistance
  - The direct assistance is provided through the expertise and potentials of related SEAMEO and other units, and indirect assistance through coordination with related departments and sectors.

- SEAMEO CHAT received permission from the Ministry of Education, Myanmar to implement its Community Involvement Programme
  - in the Basic Education Middle School No. 3 Insein in 2004
  - and in the Basic Education Primary School No.6 Kyeemyindine in 2013.










#### **BEMS Insein**




## Students in Ethnic group (BEMS No. 3 Insein)

















## Gathering and Sharing Teaching Experiences of the Teachers Programme

 Participated in several meeting conducted at the schools attended by teachers, parents and school communities.




