What is "Global Citizenship"?

- Global citizenship educates and prepares young people for their role in a modern world.
- This begins with an exploration of different cultures, languages and economies.
- Active global citizens care about the world they live in, and take action to support causes that have a positive impact for other communities and future generations.



Global Citizenship

- Education must be transformative and bring shared values to life.
- Education must cultivate an active care for the world
- Education must also be relevant in answering the big questions of the world today
- Education must fully assume its central role in helping people to forge more just, peaceful, tolerant and inclusive societies.
- Education must give people the understanding, skills and values they need to cooperate in resolving the interconnected challenges of the 21st century.

Qualities of the Global Citizen

- Is aware of the wider world and has a sense of their role as a world citizen
- Respects and values diversity
- Wants to tackle social injustice
- Participates in and contributes to the community at a range of levels from local to global
- Is willing to act to make the world a more sustainable place
- Believes that all children and young people have a right to an education.
- Takes action to make the world more equitable.

- For students, becoming global citizens can benefit them in other ways—skills such as problem solving, communication, collaboration, and cross-cultural awareness will benefit them immeasurably in the global era in which we live.
- To become a global citizen, students have to be creative, flexible, dedicated, and proactive. Global citizens take an active part in the emerging world community, and are committed to helping build this community's values and practices.
