# 1. Why Teachers Exchange Program?

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- To broaden the world view of teachers
- To help them develop a better understanding of other ASEAN countries
- To improve their teaching pedagogy

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## 2. How do we prepare for the Exchange?

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- Start the planning systematically
  - Grade level that the teachers teach – secondary level
  - Common subjects that the teachers teach – based on country priority
  - Responsibility & Cost sharing agreement
  - Period of exchange
  - Structure the activities during the exchange program
    - (observation, assistant, teach, reflection)
- Setting the criteria
  - recruiting the teachers
- Prepare the teachers
  - Orientation of the country education system
  - Prepare teaching materials

2 weeks: 24 November – 8 December 2018



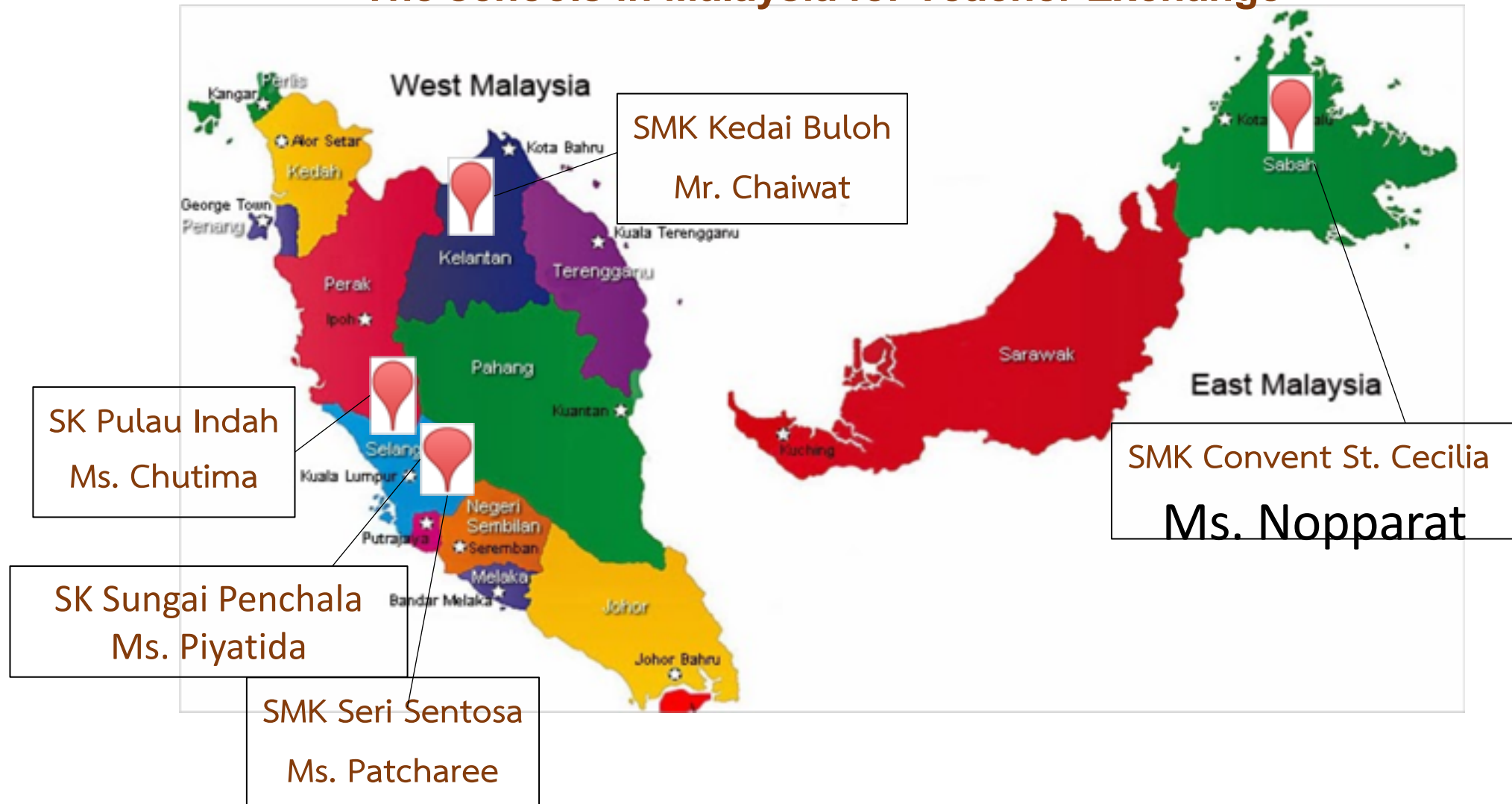

## 4. What have we learned?
