

CRICED trains 26 University teachers and others from Indonesia and Malaysia at the attached primary school

From 20 to 24 November, the Center for Research on International Cooperation in Educational Development (CRICED) of University of Tsukuba organized a training course for Center for Excellence of Lesson and Learning Studies- Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia (UPI, Partner School with the Faculty of Human Sciences, University of Tsukuba), Indonesia Association of Lesson Study Indonesia, and Malaysian Teacher Training College (IPG-Penang, Ministry of Education). 18 teachers from Indonesia and 8 teachers from Malaysia participated in the training at the attached primary school and Tokyo Campus. Internationally renowned teachers from the mathematics department of the attached primary school opened their classes on the know-how of teaching Japanese-style problem-solving, while the theory of mathematics teaching materials was lectured at the Tokyo Campus. The Centre for Research and International Cooperation in Educational Development CRICED (Director: Masami ISODA, Professor of the Faculty of Human Sciences), in collaboration with the SEAMEO-affiliated Centers of the Southeast Asian Education Ministers' Organization (SEAMEO), has developed curriculum standards and training materials for mathematics and arithmetic in Southeast Asia, developed and implemented national textbooks in Indonesia and supported teacher training in Malaysia. In Malaysia, the JV-Campus supports teacher training. In collaboration with JV-Campus, we have developed nine online courses for teacher development and training in 16 countries, with 19,000 participants from 42 countries, and have conducted local language training in Indonesia and Thailand. With the establishment of the University of Tsukuba Malaysia campus, plans have been made to conduct training courses in Indonesia and Malaysia for a total of two weeks, one week local and one week Japanese, in the future.
